SASQUATCH SHUTTLE

- ▶ Location: Sasquatch Adventures
450 NW 257th Way, Troutdale Outlets
- ▶ Multnomah Falls Express: daily, direct shuttle service to Multnomah Falls (\$5/person, free parking)
- ▶ Waterfall Loop: regular narrated tour loop service stops at Vista House, Latourell Falls, Wahkeena Falls, Horsetail Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and Multnomah Falls

WATERFALL TROLLEY


- ▶ Location: 36901 E Historic Columbia River Hwy, Corbett
On-site parking
- ▶ Run by Gray Line of Portland. Additional departure options from Portland
- ▶ Hop-on, hop-off service to Crown Point, Latourell Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, Angels Rest, Wahkeena Falls, Multnomah Falls, Triple Falls, Horsetail Falls, and Ainsworth State Park

COLUMBIA GORGE EXPRESS

- ▶ Connects with MAX train in Portland at Gateway Transit
- ▶ Service stops at Portland, Troutdale, Multnomah Falls, Cascade Locks, and Hood River
- ▶ Run by Columbia Area Transit (CAT)
- ▶ Single trip tickets and extended use passes are available
